

Mixed Greens

Mixed greens are a grower's dream with their ability for dense planting and multi-cut harvesting. Grown for baby leaf mixes or for full-leaf bunching, greens add deep colors, flavor, and texture whether cooked or raw.



Darkibor

Curly Kale

Quintessential kale with dense, curly leaves with rich peppery flavor.



Endive

Beautiful incised leaves with nutty flavor. Slower growing, but less chance of tip burn.



Rainbow Swiss Chard Bright, bold colored stems with rich green leaves and earthy flavor.



Red Leaf

Amaranth

Heart-shaped leaves with a blush of red in the center. Taste similar to spinach.



Red Sweet Swiss Chard Mild chard flavor with deep red stems and veins.



Scarlet Curly Kale Curly style, similar to Darkibor, with red leaf tips and veins. Wonderful cooked or raw!



Radish

Peppery flavor in both the root and the leaves! Tops make an interesting addition to salad mixes or soups



Red Russian

Heritage Kale Large, flat leaves with ruffled edges and red veins. Light flavor and wonderful texture.



Spinach

Traditional smooth leaves with deep color and rich green taste.

Asian Greens

Commonly stir-fried or used in soups, these tender leaves and crunchy stalks have made their way into grilled dishes and salad mixes. Their smooth, yet rich flavor adds a fresh and unique quality not found with other greens.

Bok Choy



Dean May Full size

Beautiful dark green. Best flavor at full size.



Dwarf Bok Baby variety

True baby bok with quick growth and rich choy flavor. Dense 2" heads with deep green leaves and white stalks.



Dwarf Green Baby variety

Densely headed variety with full choy flavor.



Li Ren

Baby variety

Harvested at 5" tall and ready to use - no chopping required. Tender lime green stalk and leaves.



Mei Qing Full size

Similar to Li Ren, but grows 8-10" to form vase-shaped base with large and compact oval leaves.



Red Pac Baby variety

Striking leaves with smooth flavor. Grown as baby leaf or baby head. Leaves turn green when cooked.
